All entrants must wear blaze orange hunting vests when running their dogs. Spectators will be permitted to walk all braces (blaze orange will be required on Master/Senior courses)

GPS tracking collars are permitted as per AKC guidelines

Clubs request that dogs not be left unattended on stake-out chains. If you will not be in the immediate area, please crate your dog.
